

(Evasive) Driving Courses

The (Evasive) Driving Courses training program provides the attendee with the knowledge and skills necessary to function in the role of a security driver. The program consists of one day of classroom work, followed by a full day of behind-the-wheel exercises to ensure that all attendees can apply the learned skills and techniques.

- Learn to detect and identify improvised explosive devices specific to vehicle operations.
- Study historic attacks on executives and learn how these attacks could have been detected and avoided.
- Understand the dynamics that affect vehicle handling and operation.
- Learn the characteristics of vehicular ambushes and the techniques to defeat them.

Apply techniques learned in the classroom while performing the following practical manoeuvres:

- Serpentine course
- Forward 180-degree turn (bootleg turn)
- Reverse 180-degree turn (j-turn)
- High-speed turn and brake 2
- Swerve-to-avoid (anti-ambush exercise)
- Pursuit evasion course
